NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING on Tuesday, August 27, 2024 – 1:30 PM City Hall, Room 400, 1 Dr. Carlton B. Goodlett Place, San Francisco, CA 94102, at the Regular Meeting of the SAN FRANCISCO PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION (SFPUC):

The Commission will hold a hearing and take possible action to approve a SFPUC-administered Irrigation Controller Rebate Program (the Program). The Program is intended to encourage residential, commercial, institutional, and industrial properties in the SFPUC's retail service area with existing irrigation systems to install EPA WaterSense labeled weather- or soil-moisture adjusting irrigation controllers to reduce water waste from over irrigation. Rebates can be for stand-alone controllers or add-on/plug-in devices that upgrade existing, compatible irrigation timers. SFPUC will provide a maximum rebate of up to \$250 for small landscape customers and \$35 per active station for large landscapes over 10,000 square feet. The Water Conservation Section will administer the rebate program in coordination and in compliance with SFPUC accounting and City of San Francisco Controller's Office guidelines. The rebate program will be funded from the SFPUC Water Conservation Section's operating budget.
