

# SCP Submittal Guidelines

Dear Stormwater Control Plan (SCP) Project Applicants and Property Owners,

Effective January 1, 2021, hardcopy SCP submittals will no longer be required for projects using the [Parcel SCP Project Information Form](#). Projects using the [Multi-Phase SCP Project Information Form](#) must continue to submit both electronic PDF and hardcopy SCPs.

## Please submit SCPs as follows:

- For projects submitting via **'Parcel SCP Project Information Form'**: Submit an **electronic PDF ONLY** of the SCP and [SCP Review Fee Form](#) to [StormwaterReview@sfgwater.org](mailto:StormwaterReview@sfgwater.org).
- For projects submitting via **'Multi-Phase SCP Project Information Form'**:
  - Submit an **electronic PDF** of the SCP and [SCP Review Fee Form](#) to [StormwaterReview@sfgwater.org](mailto:StormwaterReview@sfgwater.org) **AND**
  - Submit a **hardcopy** SCP by mail to

## Additional guidance:

- Confirm SCP is complete per the [SCP Instructions](#) and [SCP Preparation Checklist](#).
- Provide electronic SCP package as a single collated PDF file.
  - Provide a Bookmark for all SCP section headers that match the 'Table of Contents' provided in the SCP.
  - Provide a 'Page Label' for CDs sheets that match the sheet number provided on the drawing.
  - Provide page orientation for on-screen review (i.e. not sideways).
  - Flatten and compress the PDF prior to sending.
  - Submit via company FTP site (preferred), or SFPUC Sharefile site (if needed and requested).
  - Provide electronic copy of the completed 'SCP Review Fee Form,' and copy of check if available.
- Submit check and completed 'SCP Review Fee Form' directly to SFPUC Cashiers Unit per [SCP Review Fee and Check Submittal Guidelines](#).
