## Wawona and Vicente Streets Stormwater and Water Main Replacement

**Description:** As part of the Sewer System Improvement Program, the San Francisco Public Utilities Commission (SFPUC) will install a new sewer pipe under Vicente Street, from Wawona Street to 34th Avenue, and replace the aging water transmission and distribution mains on Wawona Street, 15th Avenue, and on Vicente Street west of 19th Avenue.

When: The anticipated start date of construction is the week of November 1, 2021. Workdays and hours (weather permitting) are Monday – Friday, 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Some night work and weekend work may be required, in which case advanced notice will be given. Weather and/or construction issues may impact the schedule.

Where: This segment of construction activities will occur in the roadway of Vicente Street between 34th and 33rd avenues, with traffic control measures extending one block east and west. Construction at this block is anticipated to complete in 2-3 weeks. Crews will then move east one block along Vicente Street for construction at the next block for 2-3 weeks, eastward towards 20th Street. Staging areas are along the side streets adjacent to Vicente and Wawona streets. See maps for construction and staging impact locations.

### What to expect:

- While the contractor is required to abide by the City's noise and vibration ordinances, neighbors should expect some noise and limited dust during this work. The project team will work to minimize disruption to normal neighborhood activity; however, there will be occasional inconveniences due to heavy equipment movement and other construction activities
- Through traffic during the work activities will remain open
- Some parking will be impacted for staging of equipment along the cross streets adjacent to Vicente and Wawona streets (see maps included), advanced notice will be given
- Businesses and residents in the work zone will maintain access to their properties (including entries, driveways, garages), although there may be temporary delays
- No interruption in sewer service is expected during construction
